5. List describing constipation.	side effects of newly prescribe	oed medications. For example: nausea, dizzine	ss or

6. Describe your primary problem. You can describe the primary reason you want to be seen by the doctor. This can include when the problem started, how often it occurs, what makes it better or worse, and if there is pain, describe the pain and what causes it. (describe in one sentence)
7. Inform the receptionist about multiple problems. If there is multiple problems for consultation, this will allow the staff to schedule a longer appointment for your visit. Otherwise, if you make an appointment for one problem and you want to discuss several problems, the office might ask that you arrange a follow-up for additional concerns. (describe in two sentences)
8. A concise list of questions. This will increase the likelihood that you receive answers to your concerns in a timely manner. It'll be difficult to return to your examination room once the doctor started examining another patient. General or routine questions can be answered by the staff while waiting on the doctor.
9. Pen and paper. This will allow you to make a note on any advice or information the doctor gives you. This will also allow you to read your condition on your doctor's website.
